THE WINE

Fun, cool, and dichotomous, the 2025 Carbonic Pinot Noir opens with Mirabelle plum, candied strawberry, and watermelon rind layered with rhubarb, cinnamon stick, and Ceylon tea. Yellow plum, orange oil, and strawberry compote unfold across the palate, balancing sweet fruit with savory detail. Crafted through carbonic maceration and aged for eight months in French oak, it highlights a more playful side of Pinot Noir, capturing the variety at its most youthful and vibrant. Enjoy now or in the next three years.

THE VINEYARD

Gård Estate Wines are 100% estate grown sustainably at Lawrence Vineyards, featuring 14 distinct vineyard sites. With elevations that range 870 feet to 1,675 feet and primarily south-facing slopes, Lawrence Vineyards provide a great framework for grape production, while the diversity of each of the locations delivers a high level of complexity to Gård wines. Lawrence Vineyards is certified sustainable.

THE WINERY

Gård, meaning "farm" in many of the Scandinavian languages, is a tribute to our family's Scandinavian heritage and farming tradition. Founded in 2006, Gård Estate Wines is a family-owned and operated estate winery in the heart of Washington's Royal Slope AVA, with vineyards on the Royal Slope, wine production in Prosser, tasting rooms in Ellensburg, Prosser, Walla Walla and Woodinville, and Gård Public House & Inn in Royal City.
